Students may make up any group classes being missed during this week at one of our 3 remaining make-up days being held throughout the year.

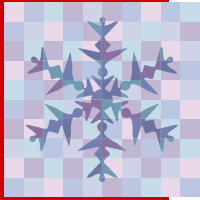
