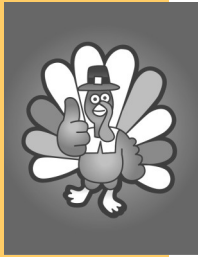
Dance Recital Costume Information Sheets will be sent home next week.

For all dance classes, students' hair is to be pulled away from the face in a pony tail or braid. Please no hair hanging down!

Dancers must come dressed appropriately for class. Please refer to your Family Information Packets if you have any questions as to what the correct attire is. There is also an explanation of attire posted on the bulletin board.

As winter and cold weather approaches, we recommend dancers, especially younger dancers, wear tights with their dance apparel. This will help to keep their muscles warm during class.

We will have all rooms set at a warm and comfortable temperature, so please have your students (both dance and music) dress in layers .

This way if they get too warm, they can take something off to cool them down.

We also ask that you please put your student's name in their dance shoes and their regular coats, boots, etc. If something gets left at the studio, we want to know who to return it to.
